Your Opportunity to get Funding for your Club

As detailed in the Government Press Release, which is on our VRA website, State Government Ministers Peter Ryan and Damian Drum have announced a major initiative to help fund all of the various shooting sports in Victoria to the tune of over \$12 million during the next 3 years. It is expected the first \$4 million will be made available in the next few months. For projects that meet the criteria, funding will be on the basis of the Government putting in \$2 for each Club \$1.

The detailed criteria and official application forms are due to be released by the Government in the next couple of weeks and these will also be posted on our VRA website and circulated to Clubs as soon as they are available. A Funding Advisory Committee, to be chaired by ex-Federal MHR David Hawker, is being established to evaluate all projects and we have been told that the VRA will be represented on this committee.

This represents a significant opportunity for your Club to gain funding for projects you may have in mind.

The VRA Council encourages your Club to have a serious think about your opportunities and make a submission on behalf of your community and your members. Projects can vary from buying land to secure range tenure, through to range and facility improvements.
