It gives me great pleasure to inform you that last Friday James Corbett was elected to the **BOARD** of the NRAA. This is indeed a great honour for both James and Victoria. James was one of three candidates who nominated for 2 vacant positions. The other successful candidate was John Fitzgerald (NSW). Jon Harding (WA) was unsuccessful.

Just by way of explanation, The NRAA is made up of 9 delegates, one from each of the 6 States, 2 Territories and North Queensland. As VRA Chairman, I am the current Victorian delegate. The 9 delegates don't manage the NRAA. Their task is to elect a 5 person **BOARD** whose responsibility it is to manage the affairs of the NRAA. Anyone who is appropriately nominated and seconded can offer themselves for a Board position. The Board elect their own Chairman. The NRAA Board currently consists of John Fitzgerald from NSW, George Edser from Queensland, Gordon Duncan also from Queensland, Bob Pedersen from Tasmania and James Corbett from Victoria. The NRAA also has a President who attends Board meetings but cannot vote. Our NRAA President is John Hartley from WA.

I spent a very interesting 3 days in Brisbane last week. Whilst delegates like me have no formal responsibility for managing the NRAA, we do spend 3 days in discussion with the Board each year advising them on various matters.
