For Service Rifles (NRAA Regs.) - Military bolt action rifles of any sovereign state in original condition fitted with their relevant service sights.



For .303 Range Rifles- Standard pattern Lee Enfield Service rifles modified in accordance with VRA Classic .303 Rules.



The Optical Class

Match 1 and 2 Shot consecutively

Match 1 300 yard Rapid Shoot (274 metres) - 2 sighters followed by 10 rounds rapid fire to count in the time of 50 seconds.

Magazines may be charged.

Match 2 300 yard Snap Shoot (274 metres) - 10 rounds as traditional military Snap Shoot exposures of 6 seconds 2 rounds applied per exposure. Magazines may be charged.

Match 3 500 yard Shoot (457 metres) - 2 sighters optional with total 15 rounds to count time limit of 12 minutes. Loaded single round. All matches shot from the prone position. Each competitor may use only one rifle for all matches.

Match 4 The Optical Class

Target at 500 yards 2 sighters - not transferable. Then 10 shots in 4 Minutes. Shooters can use a sling, sandbag or back pack as issued to rest and support the rifle. Sponsored by Frank Griffo MRC

All courses of fire will be on current VRA 600yd ICFRA target.

Qualifying Rifles

Matches 1-3 include either Standard B Class rifle (military as-issued, any country of origin) or any <u>Classic .303 Range</u> <u>Rifle from Martini Enfield, Lee-Metford and SMLE (any) as used up to 1967(Aperture sights)</u>

Match 4 Optical Class - As issued 303 or Military rifle.

Scope of similar power to the original issued. F1 rifle SSAA. Usually no more than 4X magnification.
